URC-HASS Summer Research Incubator

The Undergraduate Research Center - Humanities, Arts, and Social Sciences (URC-HASS) is offering the Summer Research Incubator (SRI). This is a virtual, entry-level program that will run for seven weeks, from **August 7 - September 22, 2023**. Within this program, students will have the opportunity to complete and present their own original research or creative project under the guidance of a graduate student mentor.
