- UCLA's academic year is a 3 Quarter System: Fall, Winter, and Spring
 - Quarter = 10 Instruction Weeks + 1 Final Exams Week
 - Summer: 4th Quarter, optional

- Average course load per quarter: 12-16 units (3-4 classes)
 - 13 units/quarter is encouraged for College of Letters and Science (L&S) students
 - 12 units/quarter: full-time for Federal Financial Aid

- Unit recommendations are based on L&S Expected Cumulative Progress (ECP).
 - ECP Guidelines are designed to promote four-year graduation rates.
