| Upper Division Major Requirements | - 9-13 classes (36-52 units) ${ }^{1}$ <br> - Minimum 2.0 Major GPA ${ }^{3}$ |
| 60 Upper Division Requirement | - 2-6 elective classes (8-24 units; courses numbered 100-199) |
| 180 Quarter Units to Graduate | - 0-8 elective classes (0-32 units) <br> - 180 total units is the minimum to graduate; 216 units is the maximum <br> - AP/IB units calculated toward 180 units total |
| 2.0 GPA Overall | - Only UC grades calculated into GPA |
| Residence | - 35 out of final 45 units must be completed at UCLA <br> - 24 units for the major must be completed at UCLA |

- Quarter = 10 Instruction Weeks + 1 Final Exams Week
- Summer: 4th Quarter, optional

- Average course load per quarter: 12-16 units (3-4 classes)
- 13 units/quarter is encouraged for College of Letters and Science (L\&S) students
