Q: Who is CAC?

A: CAC stands for "College Academic Counseling" and is one of the four College advising units in the College of Letters and Sciences.

Q: How do I know which College advising unit I'm in?

A: The best way to find out what advising unit you're in is by looking at your DARS. At the top of your report there will be a line that says "Advising/Counseling Unit" with your advising unit information.

Q: Who should I meet with if I have questions about my major and/or minor? How do I contact them?

A: Speak to the department that oversees that major/minor. Go to their website or search them in the [School and Departmental Contact List](#).

Q: Who are CAC Peer Counselors?

A: CAC Peer Counselors are undergraduate students in the College who are trained to assist students with questions about academic policies, deadlines, petitions, GE and College requirements, major and minor exploration, campus resources, pre-health requirements, and program planning.

Q: Who are College Academic Mentors? (CAMs)

A: CAMs are UCLA graduate students who are trained to help first and second years with program planning, course selection, and give guidance with the process of choosing a major. Students of any year can meet with CAMs to discuss planning for graduate and/or professional school.
