Restricted Drop Petitions

Sometimes, unexpected circumstances make it necessary to drop a class later in the term. If you're considering dropping a non-impacted class between Weeks 8-10, you'll need to submit a **Restricted Late Drop Petition** to your UCLA College Advising Unit.

What is a Restricted Late Drop?

- A Restricted Late Drop allows you to drop a non-impacted class during weeks 8-10, but it comes with specific guidelines and a petition process.
 Your transcript will note the course and week it was dropped, and a \$35 fee applies.
- This process is designed to give students flexibility while maintaining the integrity of their academic record. Keep in mind that students are limited to three (3) restricted late drops during their undergraduate career.

What Documentation Do I Need to Submit?

- Provide a PDF or JPG of an email (or signed form) from your instructor confirming your name, course, and whether you attempted or completed the final exam, paper, or project. If the final was not attempted, it must be explicitly stated.
- Missing or incomplete documentation may result in delays or denial of your petition.

What Else Should I Know?

- Petitions must be submitted by <u>4:30 PM Pacific on Friday, December 6, 2024</u>. Late petitions cannot be accepted.
- Students wishing to drop more than one class between Weeks 8-10 must meet with a College Advisor for approval.
- If you've already used your three restricted late drops, additional requests require an Impacted/Retroactive Drop petition, which is rarely approved.

- Last day to drop nonimpacted classes (Letters and Science undergraduates) by petition with instructor approval, fee, and transcript notation by 4:30pm
- Instruction ends

Friday, December 13th (Finals Week)

• Quarter ends

Friday, December 20th (Intersession)
