UIT hosts a number of web applications, primarily on MyUCLA. UIT can provide data generated by these applications along with related student data via formatted reports, excel downloads or email.

REGISTRAR'S OFFICE

The Registrar's Office provides point-in-time data, email campaigns, and course offering information for enrollment planning or program review; triages/assists with data requests from advisors to appropriate SAIT team (e.g. RSR, data from DARS); facilitates access to existing reports; generally explains how data is stored in SRDB; and serves as functional managers between departments inputting data into OASIS and extracting that data.
