Transfer Credits 101

Students may be able to apply **transfer coursework**, courses taken at other academic institutions, to fulfill **UCLA degree requirements**. It can be a useful tool for reaching your goals or making progress in your studies. Below are answers to some common questions students have about applying transfer credits to University and College requirements:

Who Should I Consult with to Fulfill my Requirements with Transfer Credits?

- Students should consult with their College Advising unit if they would like to fulfill the following degree requirements with transfer credits:
 - American History and Institutions
 - Diversity
 - Writing II
 - Quantitative Reasoning
 - College Foreign Language
 - General Education Requirements
- Students wishing to satisfy the Entry Level Writing or Writing I requirements should consult the the **Writing Programs Office.**
- For major and minor requirements, students must consult with their respective departments.

How Do I Petition a Transfer Course for a University or College Requirement?

- Students are first encouraged to visit <u>Transferology.com</u> to check whether the course they are petitioning has already been articulated for credit or reviewed.
 - If a course is listed as approved for a requirement on the Transferology, you will **not** be required to submit a petition.
- If the course you wish to complete is not listed in Transferology, please refer to the **College Advising Transfer Course Credit Database** to see if it has been approved or denied by petition. This database is only for College requirements.
 - If a course is "approved" for a requirement, upon receipt of an official transcript, the course should automatically be applied to the requirement it has been approved for.
- If the course you wish to complete is not on Transferology or the Transfer Course Credit Database, a <u>Transfer Course Credit Petition</u> must be submitted online to their College advising unit.
 - Petitions must include a digital copy of the **course syllabus** from the term the course is taken, or other relevant and appropriate information
