### **Graduation & Commencement**

Your final year at UCLA is an exciting and important time! Below you'll find a list of key action items as you prepare to graduate and answers to commonly asked questions about commencement. You may also find this <u>Graduation Checklist</u> helpful.

#### Key action items as you approach graduation:

- Double check your degree expected term on MyUCLA and update if needed (MyUCLA > Academics > Academic Profile > Declare Candidacy Term).
  - Freshman admits are automatically granted through Spring *or* Summer of their 4th year.
  - Transfer admits are automatically granted through the Fall of their 3rd year
  - If you need to extend beyond this to finish your degree requirements, you will need to submit a <u>Time To Degree Petition</u> to request an exception. Speak with a College Advisor for more details.
  - If you will be studying abroad during your last year at UCLA, check in with College advising prior to your program regarding any necessary petitions or other paperwork that may be needed.
  - The deadline to declare candidacy for the current term (Fall, Winter, or Spring) is Friday of finals week.
    - The deadline for summer is Friday Week 6 of Session C.
- Meet with an <u>academic advisor</u> to verify your degree progress.
- Fill out the Senior Survey (you must manually opt-in or opt-out on MyUCLA) to activate your ability to order tickets once available in May 2025.

#### Who is eligible to walk at Commencement in June 2025?

- Fall '24, Winter '25, Spring '25, Summer '25 graduates
- If you have completed or will be completing your degree in a different term, you will need to have an approved **Special Inclusion Petition** to participate

# What's the difference between the College & departmental commencement ceremonies?

- The <u>College ceremony</u> is for all students with majors in the College of Letters & Sciences. For the class of 2025, this will take place on **Friday**, **June 13th**.
- <u>Departmental ceremonies</u> are specific to your major and minor department(s) and times/dates vary. This is when your individual name will be called and you will have the opportunity to walk across the stage.

#### When are commencement tickets available?

- You can request <u>College Commencement Ceremony tickets</u> from Thursday, May 1st at 12:00pm through Sunday, May 4th at 11:59pm.
  - You will be asked to indicate your time preferences for the three identical ceremony options (11:00 am, 3:00 pm, or 7:00 pm). You will be able to request one FREE graduate ticket and up to four FREE guest tickets.
- Check with your department regarding when departmental ceremony tickets will become available. It may be helpful to check if your department has a mailing list you can join if you have not already, as departments often send out important updates regarding commencement this way.

#### **DATES & DEADLINES**

#### Friday, April 11th (Week 2)

- Last day to <u>drop impacted</u> <u>classes</u> by 11:59 p.m.
- Last day to <u>change study list</u> (<u>add/drop)</u> without fee through MyUCLA.

#### Friday, April 18th (Week 3)

- Last day for undergraduate students to <u>add classes</u> through MyUCLA
- <u>Financial aid audit</u> census date; enrolled units verified to determine eligibility for term.
- Reduced units audit of approved undergraduates (10 or fewer units) and graduate students (6 or fewer units) for reduced fee eligibility

#### Friday, April 25th (Week 4)

 Last day to <u>drop nonimpacted</u> <u>classes</u> without transcript notation through MyUCLA.
