# Office of the Dean of Students Services and Resources

Services Provided, but not limited to:

- Dean On-Call Program
- Assist students with issues that require coordination between departments
- Assistance with academic religious accommodations and academic adjustments
- Dean Certifications
- University Grievance Procedures:  
Debt-Related Holds, Disability Discrimination, and Student Privacy Violations (FERPA)

# Office of Student Conduct

Upholds the Student Code of Conduct and Student Group Code of Conduct

- Individual Code: Includes 32\* sections of prohibited behavior
- Student Group Code: Includes 34\* sections of prohibited behavior

# Academic Dishonesty

- When accusations of academic dishonesty occur, the Office of Student Conduct is responsible for reviewing and adjudicating suspected violations.
- Academic dishonesty includes, but is not limited to:
  - Cheating
  - Plagiarism
  - Fabrication
  - Multiple Submissions
  - Facilitating Academic Dishonesty
  - Unauthorized Collaboration

# ChatGPT and Artificial Intelligence (AI)

- April 4, 2023: UCLA provided a statement regarding the expectations for ChatGPT and use of AI in academics; this guidance cites the Student Code of Conduct.
- ChatGPT and AI tools for course assignments is equivalent to receiving assistance from another person. Individual instructors have the authority to establish course policies for the use of ChatGPT and AI tools.
- Acceptable use may vary from course to course. Instructor should be consulted for clarification.

### Concern

- Timing affects DR application
- Should be raised, regardless of enrollment/ assignment

### Referral

- Instructor of Record account
- Materials must be included

### Case opens

- 5 Business days from referral\* (redactions)
- Holds placed if appropriate/ Professor Notification

### Review

- <90 Day timeline for administrative resolution
- Appeals and Hearings\*

# HOLDS (DOS, but not DOS)

- DQ – Degree Hold (  $\geq 160$  units for Undergrads, or all Grads)
- DI – Services Hold (unresponsive student)
- DI/RD/DJ – Suspension/ Dismissal Holds

# Why does UCLA have a new interim Code?

## Introduction of interim Appendix H

- *Policies Applying to Campus Activities, Organizations and Students (PACAOS)* updated to unify all of the UC campuses
- Interim period is projected for half of 2026
- Campus comment on both the local implementation and the systemwide policies

## Differences in the Codes

- Timeline is now included in the policy.
- Framework changed: For UCLA, from a response-option framework to a sanction-based framework.
- Recommendations across the years: Course selling, AI language, TPM policies, violations of law, and others.
